

Report on national symposium on Kashi Tamil Sangamam held on 19th February, 2025

As per the directives of the Ministry of Education, Govt. of India, the Department of Hindi, Sikkim University organised an online national symposium on Kashi Tamil Sangamam on Wednesday, 19th February, 2025. The programme was presided by the Hon'ble Vice- Chancellor Prof. Dr. Jyoti Prakash Tamang. The invited speakers for the program were Prof. P.
